

Traditional Orchards in Gloucestershire

Come and hear about the People's Trust for Endangered Species campaign to help our beleaguered orchards and see some really wonderful, actively managed ones.

Anita Burroughs, Orchard Project Officer, will start us off with a short introduction to the work of PTES and orchards. Then we will walk out to Chris Parson's orchard nearby. Lunch will be back at the meeting place, Flaxley School Room and then in the afternoon we will walk up to Pear Tree Farm. Pear Tree Farm is on Pope's Hill and if the weather is kind we should get spectacular views across the Severn Valley to the Cotswolds – but knowing our luck it will probably be 10/10ths rain and no visibility at all! Do come prepared for all weathers.

Meet at Flaxley School Rooms at 10 for 10.30. Flaxley is a tiny village just off the B4224 and is between Westbury on Severn and Micheldean. Don't forget your packed lunch – but hot water, cups etc should be available in the School Room.
