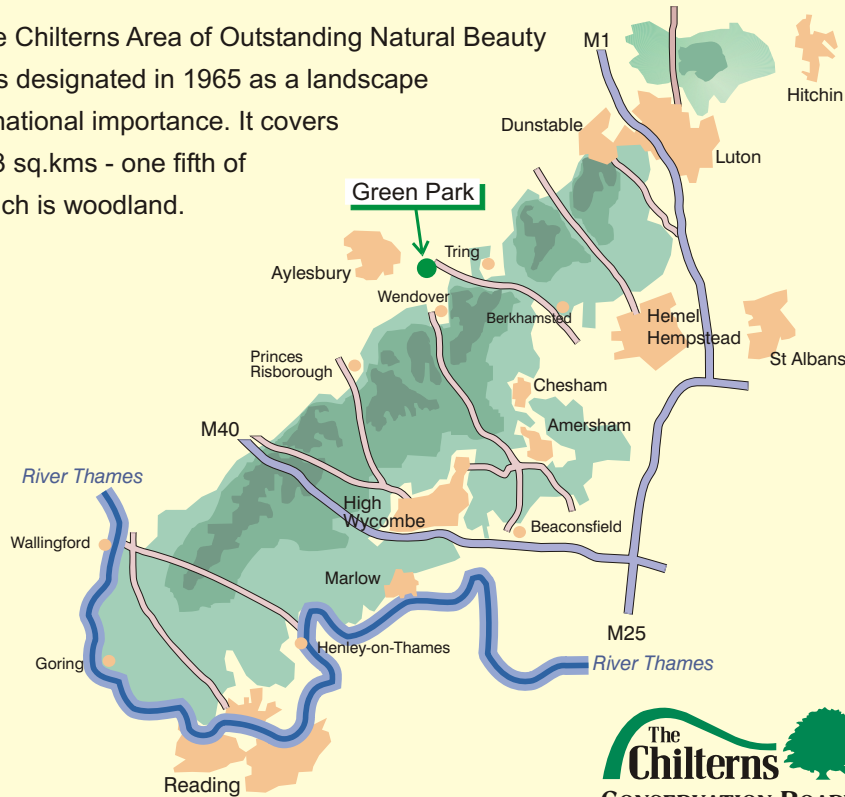


Chilterns Woodland Conference
