

Woodland Trust Community Woodland Network Grant 2003 / 4

Greyfield Wood Support Group Progress Report.

1. The grant was used to purchase three essential items of equipment for the group, a chainsaw, a strimmer and a digital camera.

The chainsaw is a Stihl MS 260 which replaces an old and unreliable secondhand saw which was purchased by the group some years ago.

The strimmer is a Stihl KM 85R and will be extremely useful in carrying out maintenance within the wood, in particular to the two additional glade/picnic areas recently created by the group for enjoyment by the community as a whole.

The camera is a Cannon Powershot G5 Digital Camera which will not only enable the group to record and create an archive record of our project work within the wood, but will also provide us with the technical ability to communicate more fully with our local community, Parish Councils, Wildlife Groups and Weekly Press.
